Job Title of Open Position: Forensic Pathologist/ Assistant Medical Examiner, Regional Forensic Center, Office of the Medical Examiner for Knox and Anderson Counties; Clinical Assistant Professor, The University of Tennessee Medical Center/Knoxville.

Qualifications: ABP, AP/FP Board Certification or AP Board Certification with the requirement to obtain FP certification within one year of employment; Medical Licensure, State of Tennessee; experience in field of medico-legal death investigation; possess and maintain a Tennessee Driver's License.

Responsibilities: Investigation of deaths that fall under the jurisdiction of the Knox and Anderson Counties Medical Examiner. The performance of hospital and private autopsies as directed. The performance of examinations and the review of ancillary tests, records and reports necessary to certify the cause and manner of death. Provide courtroom testimony as requested. Teaching responsibilities for pathology residents and medical students, with an adjunct faculty appointment at the University of Tennessee Medical Center - Knoxville. Participation in domestic violence and childhood death review committee meetings.

About the Office and Region: The Knox County Regional Forensic Center is in a state-of-the-art and NAME accredited 18,000 sq. ft. autopsy facility. The facility features separate autopsy and administration area and assigned professional staff parking steps from the entrance. The facility recently installed a full body forensic scanner. The Regional Forensic Center houses the Knox and Anderson County Medical Examiner's Office, and a Forensic Anthropology Division offering medico-legal consulting autopsy service for a population of approximately 1.5 million people in East Tennessee, southeastern Kentucky, and western North Carolina. The Regional Forensic Center covers 25 counties in the area immediately surrounding Knox County, Tennessee. This position will be in addition to three other experienced board-certified Forensic Pathologists. The Knox County Forensic Center also employs eight ABMDI certified investigators, eleven autopsy technicians, four full-time business office staff and a Senior Director for administration and operations.
