KC RFC is currently accepting applications for Locum Tenens forensic pathologists to assist the full-time forensic pathologists with a growing caseload in Knoxville, TN. Knoxville's vibrant urban city has unparalleled natural beauty and is located next to the Great Smokey Mountain National Park.

LOCUM TENENS POSITION INFORMATION AND COMPENSATION

- Successful candidates will receive \$3,000.00 per day
- Expenses, travel and accommodation not covered; however great rate at a local hotel
- Perform autopsies/external examinations except for homicide, infant, or high-profile autopsy cases
- Be able to cover at least one weekend a month with the ability to combine weekend days with Monday. The flexibility to choose the weekend will be granted in most instances
- Be able to cover either Thanksgiving or Christmas holiday
- Be able to cover three (3) consecutive days when necessary
- Contractor will be supervised by the Chief (Deputy) Medical Examiner for the Knox County Regional Forensic Center
- Payment for services rendered will be accomplished after closure of all cases for that day.

EXPERIENCE, TRAINING, LICENSURE AND CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Graduation from an accredited school of medicine and possession of (or eligibility to obtain prior to start date) a current, unrestricted license to practice medicine in the state of Tennessee
- Five (5) or more years of practice in Forensic Pathology to include completion of an accredited fellowship in forensic pathology
- Certification by the American Board of Pathology in forensic pathology

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

- Possess a current license to practice medicine in the State of Tennessee
- Reference and background checks will be conducted on selected applicants
- Successful candidates should have the ability to work at least 3 consecutive days
- Must provide evidence of Tennessee malpractice insurance coverage.
- Must pass background check and drug screen
